

## Find Your Model & Serial Number

The water heater's **model and serial numbers** (A) are located on the **Rating Plate** (B), an adhesive sticker located in the top center of the warning labels. The model and serial numbers are listed here directly beneath the Bradford White **manufacturing facility address** (C).



## Determine the Age of Your Water Heater

EXAMPLE - Serial No: **BH**6511396 --> **B**=2005 & **H**=August

Bradford White uses a 20-year letter designation rotation in serial numbers. Therefore, water heaters manufactured 20 years apart will have the same serial number "letter year" designation (i.e. A = 2004 and 1984).

The serial number on all Rheem water heating labels contain ten (10) digits. It follows the example below: EXAMPLE – Serial No. 1209D01234

Your warranty is based on the date of manufacture and the warranty code listed in the model number. To verify if your water heater is in warranty you can call 1-800-621-5622 and listen for the prompt to take you to warranty.

Manufactured in December 1991, 50 gallons, 36000 BTU's per hour, set to work with Natural Gas only.

The picture below shows the entire Rheem plate. EXAMPLE: Model No. 62MV-520 Serial No. 0884810488



Manufactured in August 1984, 50 gallon electric, equipped with 4000 watt elements.



General Electric® water heater serial numbers are written the same way as Rheem serial numbers. However, there are a few different styles of serial numbers for these tanks.

Serial number styles/formats found:

**Style 1:** 1108903259

First 2 digits indicate month of manufacture, second 2 digits indicate year of manufacture

**Style 2:** GE 09022246884

First 2 numbers indicate month of manufacture, second 2 numbers indicate year of manufacture

**Style 3:** GENG 0601D13586

First 2 numbers indicate month of manufacture, second 2 numbers indicate year of manufacture

**Style 4:** RN0197147899

First 2 numbers indicate month of manufacture, second 2 numbers indicate year of manufacture

AO Smith




For AO Smith water heaters, including the brands National, Glascote, and Perma-Glas, the first 2 numbers in the serial number indicate the year of manufacture, and the second 2 numbers indicate the month of manufacture.

Example: Serial No. BG99–0813397-210 would have been built in year 99 (1999) in month 08 (August).

Check your warranty: 1-800-447-6575

It's a little harder to find the info on the AO SMITH plate.



AO SMITH puts year first (1991), and month second (07, or JULY).



American's puts year first, then the week the tank was built.

EXAMPLE: In the example below, the tank was made in the 50<sup>th</sup> week of 1999.



EXAMPLE: In the example below, the tank was made in the 17th week of 1998.
